CURRENT CAPITAL/ENDOWMENT PROJECTS IN NEED OF SUPPORT



- **Priority 1:** Mrs. Hunter Smith has pledged a generous gift to help build a new cabin dedicated to housing our Med Staff and providing a training and education space for med students, nursing students and other healthcare professionals. **THE OPPORTUNITY:** CHT needs to raise \$100,000 to complete this important project!
- **Priority 2:** In the spring of 2009, the 20th Century Merchant's Association honored a recent member by renovating one cabin at CHT soup to nuts. We have detailed plans and materials lists to follow for each of our remaining 4 cabins. **THE OPPORTUNITY:** \$70,000-75,000 to renovate each of the remaining 4 cabins. Will take on one at a time.
- To maintain our 75 acre facility, CHT employs just one part-time Facility Manager with a meager budget. . **THE OPPORTUNITY:** Contribute to a Facility Endowment, goal: \$250,000.
- CHT provides close to \$100,000 in financial aid to eligible campers each year. These campers deserve the camp experience despite financial hardship. **THE OPPORTUNITY:** Contribute to a Campership Endowment, goal: \$250,000.
- The CHT pool, built in 1977, has some aches and pains. **THE OPPORTUNITY:** Contribute to a Pool Endowment, goal: \$100,000.
